Conditions of Play & Eligibility

Participation in the 2007 Saskatchewan Canadian Open is open to members of any National Association recognized by the BWF and any players who are members in good standing with Badminton Canada's recognized member associations. To enter, national associations should list their players according to national ranking on the entry form. Canadian entries are acceptable on an individual basis. The 2007 Saskatchewan Canadian Open will be conducted under the official rules of the BWF. In the event of disputes, the decision of the tournament referee will be final.

Scoring

Best of three games to 21 points – rally in all events.
